A. Review of 2021 Northwest Zone Transportation Improvement Program

Cameron Brown, WRCOG Program Manager, reviewed the 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), the current Zone balance, and the projected revenue for the next five years. The Committee reviewed the projects under the existing TIP.

The City of Jurupa Valley discussed additional funding of the Market Street Bridge Project. An additional \$5,400,000 was allocated to this project.

The County of Riverside requested an additional \$400,000 for the Wood Road Widening (Krameria Avenue to Cajalco Road) Project.

The City of Riverside requested \$1,900,000 for the final Construction Phase of Iowa Ave (Martin Luther King to University Ave) Project.

The City of Eastvale requested an additional \$2,640,000 for the Limonite Avenue Bridge Project. The eligible funding will be combined with the Limonite Avenue Extension Project from Hellman to Archibald.

Action:

1. Recommended that the Northwest Zone Executive Committee approve the amended 2021

Northwest Zone Transportation Improvement Program.
